

2015-2016 SDSA Uniform List



All Students:

➤ All bottoms – tan or navy

- Pants, shorts, or casual dress slacks
 - With or without cuffs
 - Flat front or pleated
 - **CAN NOT** be form fitting
 - **NO** spandex materials, tan colored denim, corduroy, hip huggers, bell bottom, cargos

GIRLS MAY ALSO WEAR: shorts, skorts, capris, pleated skirts, jumper- to be no shorter than 2” above the knee when kneeling.

Suggested: wear bike shorts or similar item underneath that cannot be seen, especially younger students

➤ Solid colored polo (long & short sleeve) shirt

- Button neck (**no more than 4 closed fingers from the collar bone- district policy**)
- **No** snaps, zippers, cap sleeves, spandex material, or sleeveless
- Long enough to remain tucked in
- Must not be form fitting
- No contrasting stitching
- Undergarments may not be visible
- Solid t-shirts may be worn underneath, but not seen

➤ Solid colored turtleneck or mock

- No sparkle material, spandex
- Must be worn under a sweatshirt or cardigan

➤ Solid colored long-sleeved sweatshirt (crewneck)

- No hoods, zippers or fleece
- Must wear turtleneck or polo shirt underneath

➤ Solid colored, plain cardigan – (button-up sweater)

- No hood, zipper, sparkle material
- Must wear turtleneck or polo underneath
- Waist length
- $\frac{3}{4}$ length sleeve or longer

➤ Socks, stockings, or tights must be worn

- Any color
- No leggings

➤ Belt- must be worn if you have belt loops

- Belts must have buckles
- No metal chain belts
- Nothing hanging down (no tassels)

Shoe Options-

➤ Flats or sneakers with full toe and full back/heel

- If shoes have laces, laces must be tied
- Shoes must be fitted
- Ankle height or lower
- No boots

❖ Boots may be worn to school on cold days, but students will be required to change into uniform shoes when they enter the building. Boots can be stored in lockers during the day.

- ❖ Clothing should NOT make noise
- ❖ No long sleeve shirts worn under short sleeve polo shirts.
- ❖ No scarves/ bandanas/ hats.
- ❖ Jewelry or hair may not be used to disguise uniform infractions.
- ❖ Each school in the IRSD has the right to modify their dress policy as necessary and reserves the right to determine what might be disruptive and unsafe.
- ❖ *ON NON-UNIFORM DAYS, ALL STUDENTS MUST FOLLOW THE IRSD DRESS CODE.

Consequences of breaking the uniform policy-
(A log will be kept of students who break the uniform policy)

1. For the first offense, the student will be sent to the nurse and a note will be sent home. Students will also receive the correct piece of uniform so they are in proper uniform attire.
2. For the second offense, the student will be sent to the nurse and the uniform violation will be logged. They will then be sent to the office to contact parents or guardians by phone. Parents or guardians will be required to bring their child proper uniform attire. Student will remain in the office until proper uniform attire is obtained.
3. For the third offense, the student will have an office referral.
