Grades 7 and 8

The following list includes all items for ALL core academic classes needed throughout the year. (You do NOT need to purchase additional/multiple sets of supplies.) An ample supply of these items will ensure that you are always prepared.

- Pencil pouch or container, clearly labeled with personal information
- Cap erasers
- Pens (blue or black ink)

- One (1) 1- *or 2-inch binder (to be shared with ELA & social studies) *2-inch only if you want to keep your SpringBoard book in your binder
- Two (2) packs of dividers
- Four (4) college ruled single subject notebooks OR one (1) 5-subject notebook, clearly labeled with personal information
- Graph paper
- Glue sticks
- Scotch tape
- Two (2) steno notebooks (with the line down the middle), clearly labeled with personal information

★The above items are for your own use and should be with you every day. Do NOT turn them in to your teacher.

★★Under current guidelines, teachers are not able to distribute materials during in-person instruction. It is essential that you have your own supply of the above items in your book bag!

Please bring the following supplies to your homeroom teacher:

- Individual packs of tissues
- Hand Sanitizer
- One (1) pack of Expo dry erase markers
- One (1) box of clear Ziploc bags: either gallon, quart, or sandwich size

Additional items to consider:

If you would like a personal agenda, you may purchase one that is specific to your needs. It should have a monthly snapshot and a place to record daily assignments and events. SDSA will not be providing agendas to students in grades 7 and 8.

You may want to consider purchasing a protective Chromebook case to minimize the potential for damage when transporting devices to and from school during hybrid instruction.
